After excusing themselves for a GEO GEO programme of last March, wherein they showed doubtful scenes of illegal hunting (mounted scenes from the usual non-credible anti-hunting lobby), they said that apparently such illegal hunting does not take place any longer in Malta and proceeded with a beautiful feature about the Maltese Islands, history and culture.

The FKNK with the help of its Italian Hunters' Organisation within FACE, had lodged a strong complaint about the GEO GEO March programme with RAI 3 and the Italian Embassy in Malta. Just last week the FKNK was advised of today's transmission by RAI 3, and this morning by means of a telephone call from the Italian Ambassador in Malta in person.
