Dr. Joseph Muscat Meets FKNK...

A delegation from the Federation for Hunting & Conservation – Malta (FKNK) met Labour Party Leader Dr. Joseph Muscat at the Labour Party Headquarters in Hamrun.

The very cordial meeting discussed crucial items that are negatively affecting hunters and trappers in this very delicate period of time, also because of incorrect application of benefits that can be utilised from the 'Birds' EU Directive itself.

It was agreed that in order for the Party to be better adjourned in a consistent manner, a working group with representatives from both sides will be set-up, through which hunting and trapping matters can be monitored, always within the ambit of EU legislation.

From its end, the Labour Party repeated that whilst European laws have to be observed, Maltese and Gozitian citizens, including hunters and trappers, should not be treated worse than other European citizens.

The working group will also be meeting so that the Federation, as it has always done, would be in a position to inform its members with both main political Parties qualified opinions as necessary.
