Wildlife Crime Unit...

The Federation for Hunting & Conservation – Malta (FKNK) is now in perfect agreement with BirdLife Malta's recent demand for the setting-up of a specialised Wildlife Crime Unit.

This is now imminent because of the escalated number of reports of killing of protected species of wild birds, ever since the verdict of the 10th September issued by the Court of Justice of the European Communities.

The FKNK therefore calls on the Prime Minister and the Minister for Justice and Home Affairs to set-up such a Unit, and until then to beef-up the present Administrative Law Enforcement Division within the Police Corps.

The FKNK repeats its warning of zero tolerance to its members who may still persist with the killing of protected wild birds species.
